


# MatchMeFast - Colour Position Mats


**Key**

Start with mat MMF Col Pos V1 (Red Cards), progress to MMF Col Pos H2 (Blue Cards).

Challenge - combine the mats and cards

## Description

- These mats are comprised of rectangular blocks.
- The contents of each block differs in colour and shape.
- One mat has blocks displayed **vertically**, the other **horizontally** (player's position is important).
- The small, coloured description bar indicates which set of cards are to be used (either red or blue).
- Start playing with Mat V1 and progress to Mat H2 and later combine the two.
- All Set 1 mats are displayed in the pamphlet on Light Blue background.

## Developmental Skills

- **Visual discrimination** - the ability to detect, recognise, and differentiate subtle differences in size, shape, colour, pattern, and orientation
- **Memory** - essential for transforming new input into long-term knowledge, supporting comprehension, skill acquisition, and critical thinking
- **Encourages colour and shape recognition**
- **Fine Motor skills** - the ability to use the small muscles of the hands, fingers and wrists to make precise, controlled movements. These skills require coordination between the brain and the muscles, as well as visual guidance (hand-eye coordination).

## Helpful Hints


**MMF** - Cards will exactly match the mats.



- The small, coloured description bar indicates which set of cards are to be used (either red or blue).
- Start playing with Mat A1 and progress to Mat A2 and later combine the two.
- All Set 2 mats are displayed in the pamphlet on Green background.

## Additional Skills

Executive functioning,  
Impulse/inhibitory control,  
Eye tracking for reading,  
Midline crossing,  
Working outside the field of vision,  
Comparing and contrasting,  
Self-regulation,  
Foreground VS Background,  
Scanning skills

**Suggestion:** Before the game begins get the players to practice e.g. Red on Green using the bricks. The 'Dealer' could call out varying combinations before moving on to the mats.





Challenge - combine the mats and cards


## Description

- All Set 2 mats are displayed in the pamphlet on Light Blue background.
