
## FIRST2FOUR: RULES



## Addition (Sum):

play in pairs/groups or as a class use dice with dots if possible (numbers are also OK)

- take turns to roll 2 dice
- add up the number of dots on both dice ( or the sum of the numbers )
- find that number on your chart
- use a brick to cover that number (only cover one number at a time)
- keep doing this until you've used all Six Bricks
- after using all Six Bricks you have to strategically move a brick each time you roll the dice - to cover the new total number (sum)
- first to four in a row or square is the winner

## Subtraction (Difference):

play in pairs/groups or as a class use dice with dots if possible ( numbers are also OK )

- take turns to roll dice
- 1 person rolls 2 dice and 1 person rolls 1 dice
- work out the difference between the two sets of dice
- find that number on your chart
- use a brick to cover that number (only cover one number at a time)
- keep doing this until you've used all Six Bricks
- after using all Six Bricks you have to strategically move a brick each time you roll the dice - to cover the new total number (sum)
- first to four in a row or square is the winner
- must shout out "FOUR"
